_____ by June 15th. **You should be able to start submitting necessary documentation through the Patient Portal, mid- May since it is currently being updated to accept Covid vaccine documents.** If you feel you qualify for medical exemption, please contact our office and we can direct you to the correct resource.

Please note that there are several vaccinations that are required to be submitted before move-in, but the Covid-19 vaccination needs to take precedence to move your application to fully confirmed. All vaccination requirements should be met before move-in this August.

After successfully submitting your vaccine documentation by June 15th deadline, we will be able to update the conditional confirmation to a full confirmation. Once fully confirmed, you will have an opportunity to select your roommate and room location per the deadlines:

Roommate Selection: Wednesday June 30 – Tuesday, July 6

Room Selection - Wednesday, July 7 – Tuesday, July 13 (you will be assigned a starting time, which will be emailed to you in early July)

Students assigned to a specific housing community should follow the above dates. Students assigned to a community will only see the available roommate potentials and rooms in the specified community.

Please keep in mind that the earlier you select your room location, the better the chances of getting your first choice. Residents who do not select a roommate or room will automatically be assigned what is available at the end of the processes.
